4. **Find 1 project that you think is simply super**
5. Turn in a sheet of paper with the following information in the heading (TYPED!!! Not written)

  - NAME of that Simply Super Project
  - TERM/YEAR and SECTION # of that Simply Super Project, e.g., Winter/2017, Sect2And... Answer the following questions about that simply super project:
  - In your own words, what PROBLEM/NEED does that simply super project address? Do not copy exactly how the student developers themselves described that simply super project (Use no more than 150 characters, including spaces, in your response.)
  - *Example: Shoppers leaving a Costco often have a problem finding their car in the huge parking lot. (88 characters with spaces)*
  - Give 2 reasons why you feel the project is simply super? (Each reason can be no more than 150 characters, including spaces, in your response.)
  - Give 1 suggestion for how and why you would extend the project, e.g., what feature would you add **and WHY?** (In TOTAL, use no more than 400 characters, including spaces, in your response)

NOTE: Writing “short” is harder than writing “long” – writing ONLY 150 characters means NO bologna, NO blah, blah, blah, NO just words... writing 150 means focused, to the point, crisply shaped ideas. You may well need to write, rewrite, rewrite, and rewrite.... Make those 150 characters SHINE!
